


eleven issues

1. Landscape


the form of the built environment is informed first by the character of the landscape_ interest in the relationship between building and landscape has been a primary issue in the discovery of the Ex/plate chess house_ horizon, topography, sun [moon], heat and humidity_ oscillating perceptions of the house within the landscape + the landscape within the house_ the notion that natural + built are inextricably linked_

2. Painting

studying the devices and operations of visual composition _ investigation of the formal relationships in/ for the Ex/plate chess house have been conducted primarily through the medium of painting. The clearing of the center [precinct making through edge definition] approach of Piet Mondriaan's classic Neoplastic works of 1921-29+, and the landscape research inherent in Richard Diebenkorn's Ocean Park paintings, have directed a formal study of the making/marking of sites within a larger field, which relyies on the controlled study of transparency and the condition of both/ and, multivalent fields, and the coexistence of plan, facade + perspective_ Twombly_

3. Precedents

4. Ground

the ground plane is conceived of as a **plastic** form able to project and deflect in order to define the spatial realms of the built, i.e. synthetic plates of terrain_

5. Garden

the relationship between building and garden is developed as a spatial + programmatic overlap constructed through the use of walls + planes as elements which allow for multiple readings of inside/interior + outside/exterior_ the ability to distinguish between house + garden is impaired_

6. Sequence

the issues of frontality, *natural* context, passage + threshold, spatial and programmatic hierarchy, and privatization have guided the formation of a spatial sequence that takes the participant from a landscape of rambling planes to a controlled realm of academically defined spaces_

7. Process

the process of **making** drawings and models has been the most informative act the development and invention of the conceptual agenda of the project_

8. Transparency

the investigation of relative levels of transparency + opacity, literal and phenomenal, have been at the center of the development of **formal relationships** throughout_

9. Materiality


- a. massive concrete + stone wall

- c. glass enclosure d. wood fence


10. Marking
