Emilio Tuñón Alvarez has been awarded with Gold Medal of Merit in the Fine Arts from the Spanish Ministry of Culture in 2014, Mies van der Rohe in 2007, Contemporary Architecture European Union in 2003 and FAD award in 2001, 2007, 2011.

Nowadays, Emilio Tuñón is Chair Professor at the Architectural Project Department of E.T.S.A.M. Additionally, he has taught as visiting faculty at Princeton University School of Architecture, Harvard Graduate School of Design, Ecole Polytechnique Federale de Lausanne, Barcelona International Architecture School, Frankfurt Städelschule, Architecture San Pablo CEU Foundation, Barcelona Architecture School, New Puerto Rico Architecture School and Navarra Architecture School.

Since 2007, Emilio Tuñón is member of the board of directors of Arquia Foundation, which was awarded with gold medal of CSCAE in 2015.

LUNCH & KEYNOTE: THOMAS VONIER



The International Union of Architects-the only global organization representing the world's architects, who now number some 3.2 million in all-elected Tom president for 2017-2020. A board-certified security professional with extensive background in protective measures for public and private facilities, he works from bases in Paris and Washington DC for public and private organizations with global operations.

Tom's practice in security planning and design has completed work throughout Africa, the former Soviet Union, East Asia, the Middle East and Europe, focusing on cost-effective solutions grounded in factual vulnerability assessments.

Tom was appointed to head a special research commission on security for US embassies and foreign mission buildings. His work on urban security control zones was featured by the National Capital Planning Commission in Washington DC and by the International Centre for Urban Security.

The 90,000-member American Institute of Architects elected Tom to serve as its president in 2017. He also served as senior regional vice president in Europe for ASIS International, the global security organization.
